The Church District of Nordfriesland invites you to focus on Climate Justice

The church district of Nordfriesland comprises of 66 parishes with 110.000 church members altogether, which is 75% of the total population. It is situated between the river Eider in the south and the Danish boarder in the north. The maximum distance from south to north is approx. 120 km, from east to west is 90 km. There are 88 church buildings, 55 parsonages and 23 church community buildings.

The church district is mostly showing rural character. It is situated on the main land as well as on islands.

The issue of climate justice is relevant for the church district because of its closeness to the coastline as well as for the UNESCO - World Nature Heritage of the Wadden Sea which reflects on the importance of this natural resource for the whole region.

The Exposure Team will get to know the specifics and perspectives of the region. The sharing and discussion with people in parishes as well as in civil society organizations may lead to own reflections on the relevance of the issue for justice issues and what that may mean in practice.
